While we are happy for you to take photos of your child on his/her first day at Nursery please ensure that no other child is included in photographs you may put on social media.



Children prefer to wear their own pants and socks should they have a 'little accident' so we ask parents to give us a set & we keep them for such a time.


Please ensure that your child's uniform is labelled. Uniforms are available from the office throughout the year.

Remember to collect your child punctually as he/she may become anxious if you are late and all the other children are gone. Please ring the school if you are unavoidably delayed.



Please check your child's home tray each day for notes as well as your child's "work of art".

In the interests of safety we would remind you that the car park is for staff use only (exceptions being children arriving by taxi or those with particular needs).

Parents will receive black bags which we ask you fill with old clothes, bedding, bags etc. It is a good way of having a clear out at home while helping the Nursery and the environment.
