If you have not already done so please return all forms (information and consent forms). Always ensure that we are updated with changes of address and mobile numbers. Please ensure you have downloaded and accessed the Seesaw app as this will be the main form of communication with you. It is also a wonderful way of seeing into your child's day as we post videos and photographs of the children "at work".

While we are happy for you to take photos of your child on his/her first day at Nursery, please ensure that no other child is included in photographs you may put on social media.



Children prefer to wear their own pants and socks should they have a 'little accident' so we ask parents to send us in a set and we will keep them for such a time. Please send them in a sealed, named zip lock bag.

Please ensure that your child's uniform is labelled. Uniforms are available from the office throughout the year.

Please supply 1 box of tissues, 1 hand sanitizer and 1 pack of wipes (eg. Pampers/other) per term.



Remember to collect your child punctually as he/she may become anxious if you are late and all the other children are gone. Please ring the school if you are unavoidably delayed.



All "works of art" created by your child will be sent home each Friday.

The front entrance door is electronic and we would remind parents to please stand back from the door once you have pressed the buzzer. The door will open automatically, very slowly. Please **do not pull** the door (or **push** the door when exiting) or it will break!

Currently, parents are not permitted to enter the building, as per DE guidance for Nursery School settings.



In the interests of safety we would remind you that the car park is for staff use only (exceptions being children with particular needs). Please ensure your child does not climb up the steps in the car park. This area is out of bounds to the children. Please follow your allocated entrance route and observe social distancing. Children must be supervised at all times.



Settling in Parent Consultations will be held in later September to update you on how your child is settling into Nursery life - further information will be sent to you during the month.



On 17<sup>th</sup> September we will hold our first fundraising event of the year. Cash for Clobber is a great scheme which generates funds for the Nursery. Parents will receive bags which we ask you fill with old but good quality clothes, bedding, bags etc. It is a good way of having a clear out at home while helping the Nursery and the environment.
