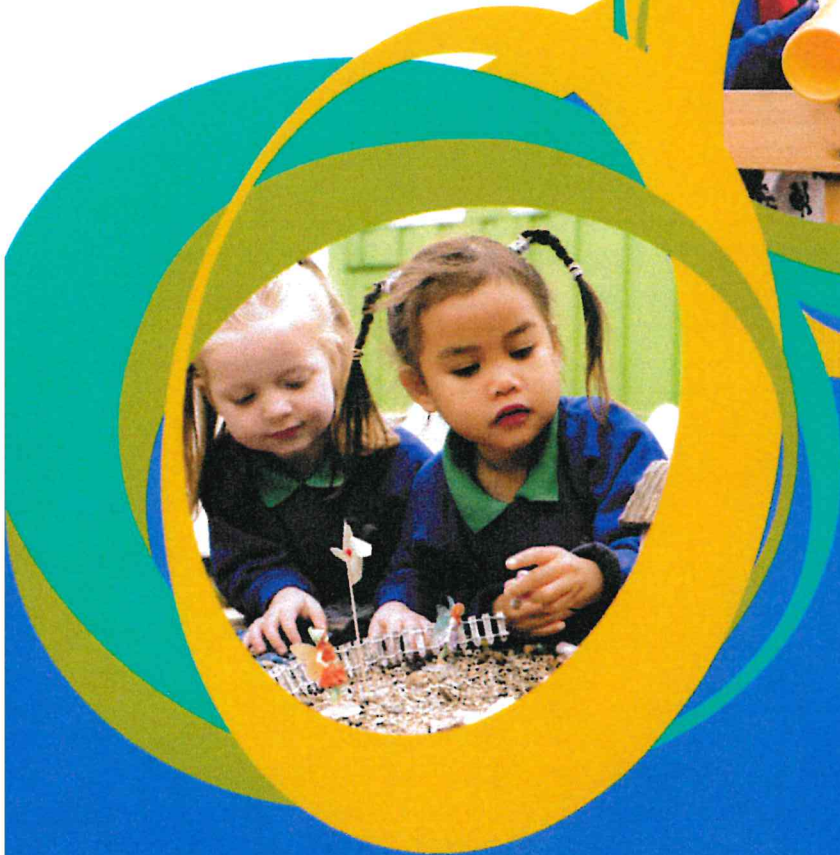

About our school . . .

Trinity Nursery School was opened in May 1976 and is under the control of the Education Authority. We are a large two unit nursery school in which 52 children attend on a full time basis. The school day begins at 8.45am and ends at 1.15pm.

The school boasts a bright, attractive building which has a comprehensive range of resources and equipment. Outdoors there are four play areas – the main playgrounds have soft surfaces and includes a shuttered area which allows the children access to physical play, even in wet weather. The grounds also include a range of stimulating role play areas, a Mud Kitchen, Music Hub, Fairy Garden, Farm, vegetable patch, bark pit and a variety of shrubs and trees to enhance play.
